2. Basis of Issuance of the Certificate : Under the section 29 of the Bangladesh Energy Regulatory Commission Act, 2003 and the regulation 9 of the Bangladesh Energy Regulatory Commission License Regulations, 2006.

3. Terms of the Certificate:

- 3.1. This Certificate shall remain valid from 11 March 2023 to 10 March 2026.
- 3.2. This Certificate shall be applicable, unless otherwise modified by the Bangladesh Energy Regulatory Commission for generation of 664.00 (Six Hundred and Sixty-Four) kW electricity in the address mentioned in the clause 1.3 above.

4. Obligations of the Certificate:

- 4.1. The Certificate-holder shall have to apply for extension of the validity of Certificate at least 30 (thirty) days before the expiry of this certificate with paying Application Fee of Taka 3,000/- (Three thousand) for three years.
- 4.2. The Certificate-holder shall not, without prior written approval of the Commission, operate any facilities for transmission or distribution of electricity outside the above mentioned location.
- 4.3. The Certificate-holder shall ensure appropriate metering facilities to measure the generated electricity and shall record it accordingly.
- 4.4. The Commission shall have the right to enter into the premises of the Certificate-holder and examine the conduct of its business and its documents in order to ensure compliance with the conditions of this letter as well as those with the regulations as would be applicable.
- 4.5. The Certificate-holder shall inform the Commission for any alteration/addition/transfer of the generator(s) at least 15 (fifteen) working days prior to the commencement of such operation.
- 4.6. The Certificate-holder shall submit the yearly energy generation report to the Commission at the time of validity extension for the previous years.
- 4.7. The Certificate-holder shall take all preventive measures for any type of accident which may occur and shall be liable for all consequential events resulting from such accidents, if any.
- 4.8. This Certificate shall not relieve the Certificate-holders from fulfilling the obligations that are required under any other Acts, Rules and Regulations prevailing in the country.
- 4.9. The Certificate-holder shall comply with the 'Environment Conservation Act, 1995' and 'Environment Conservation Rules, 1997' and shall control the sound pollution, if any.
- 4.10. The arrear/dues to the Commission will be realized by the Commission from the Certificate-holder under the 'Public Demand Recovery Act, 1913'.
- 4.11. The Commission preserves the right to cancel this Certificate for waiver from the requirement of a license at any time mentioning the cause thereof in writing.
- 4.12. The Certificate-holder shall maintain sound level, smoke and vibration from the generator within the tolerable limit & for Industrial/Commercial building generator cannot be installed on any upper floor or roof except ground floor/basement of the building.
